A clever fox, passing by, saw the cheese and wanted it for himself.

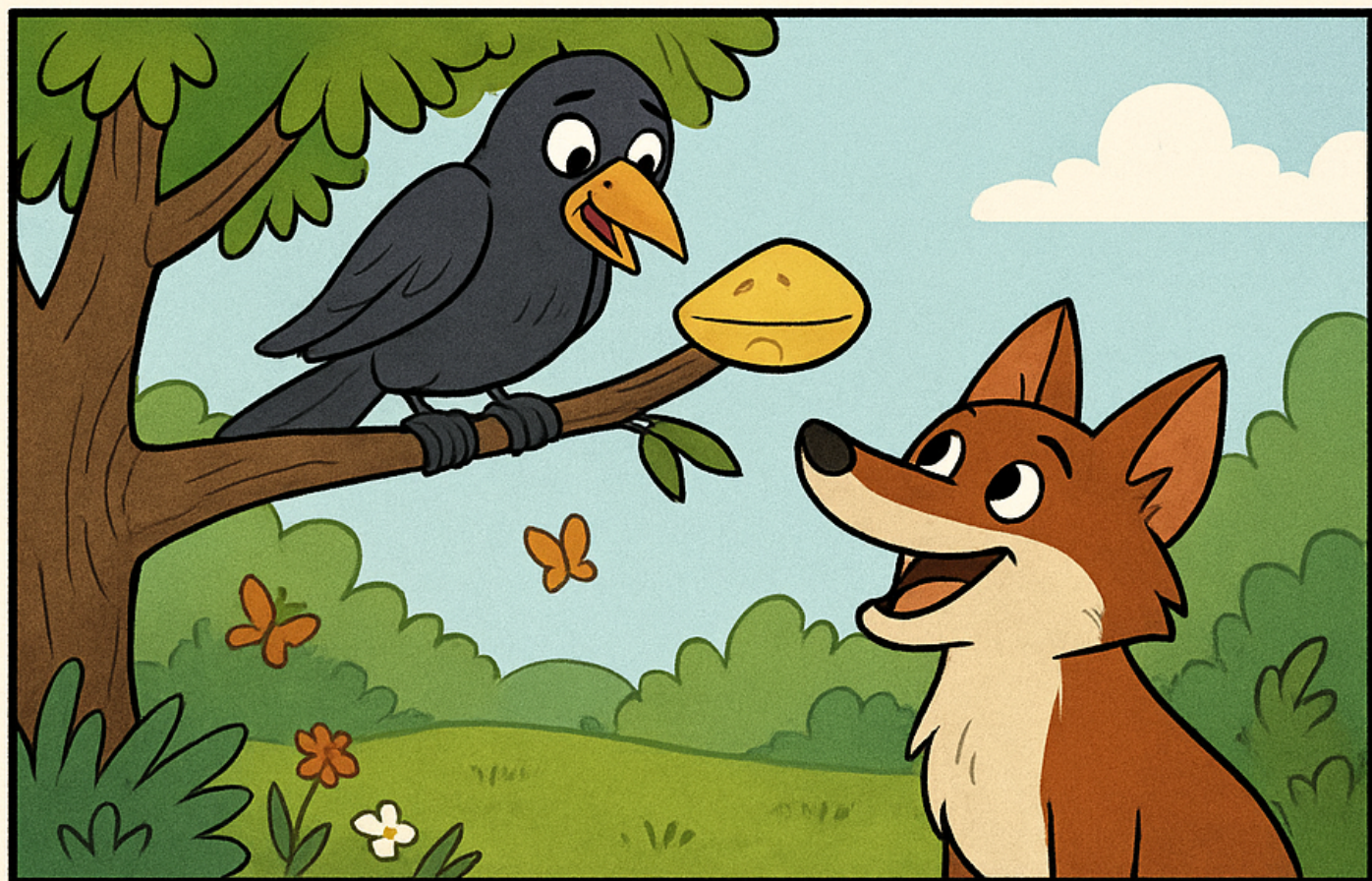

The Tortoise and the Eagle

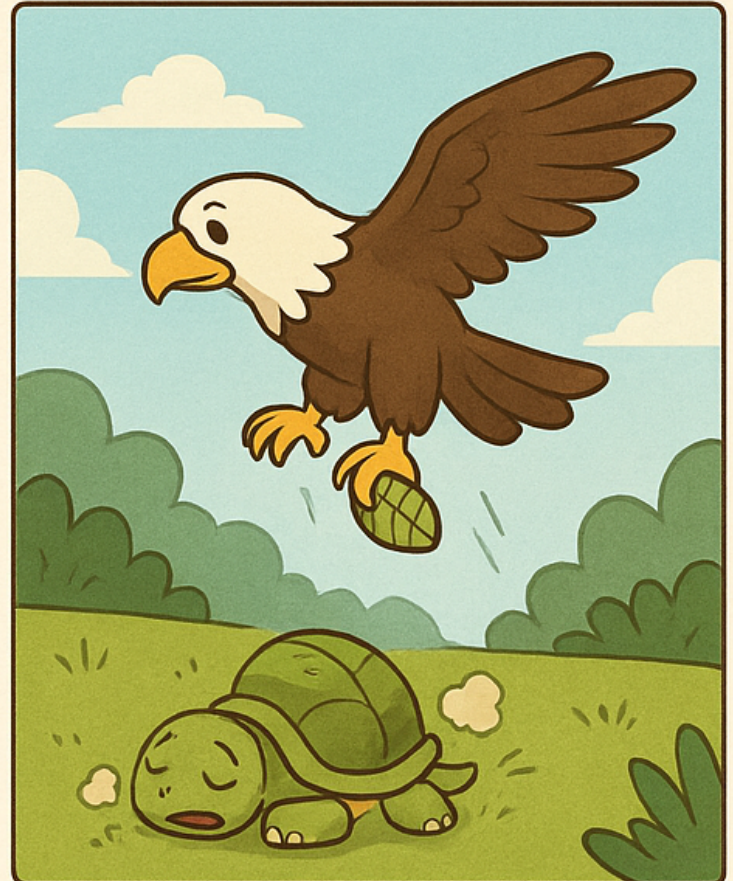
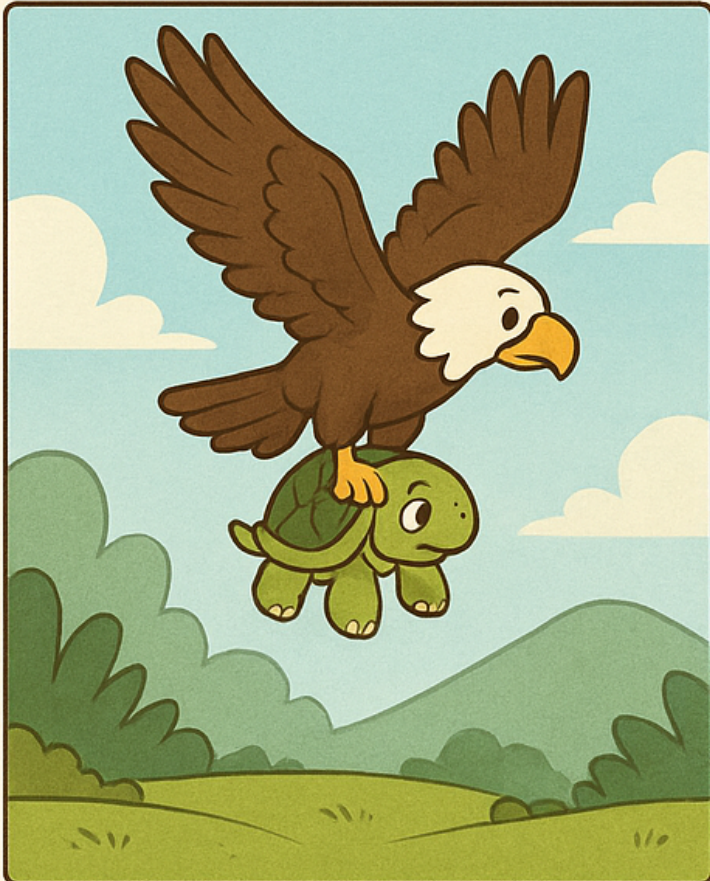
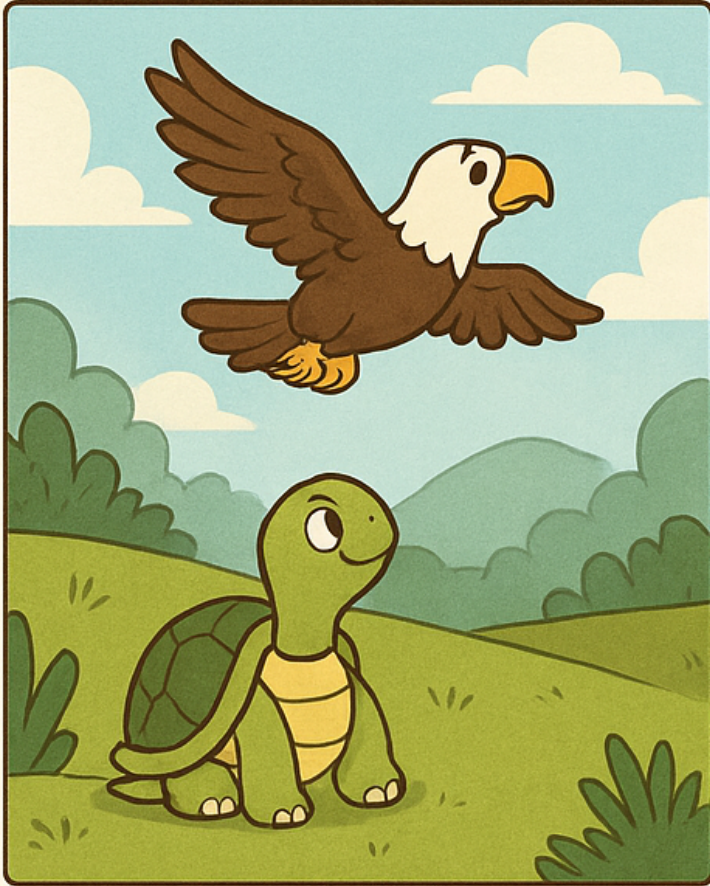

The Elephant and the Ant

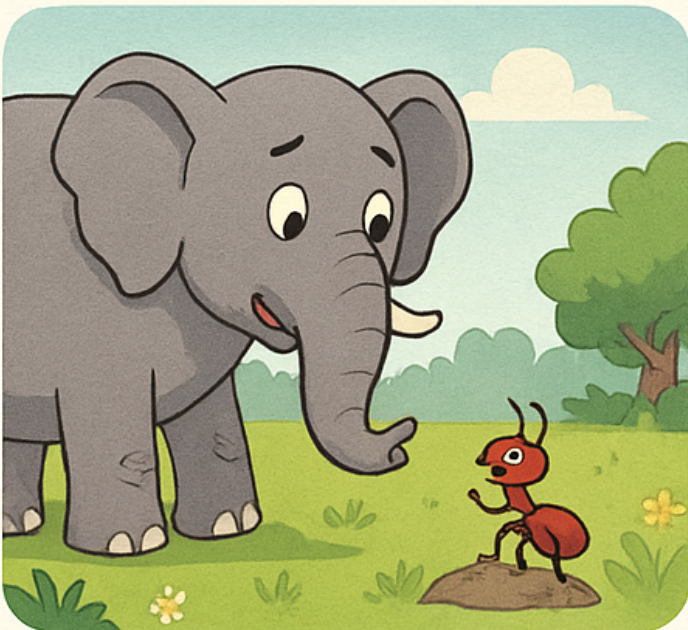
– A Lesson on Strength



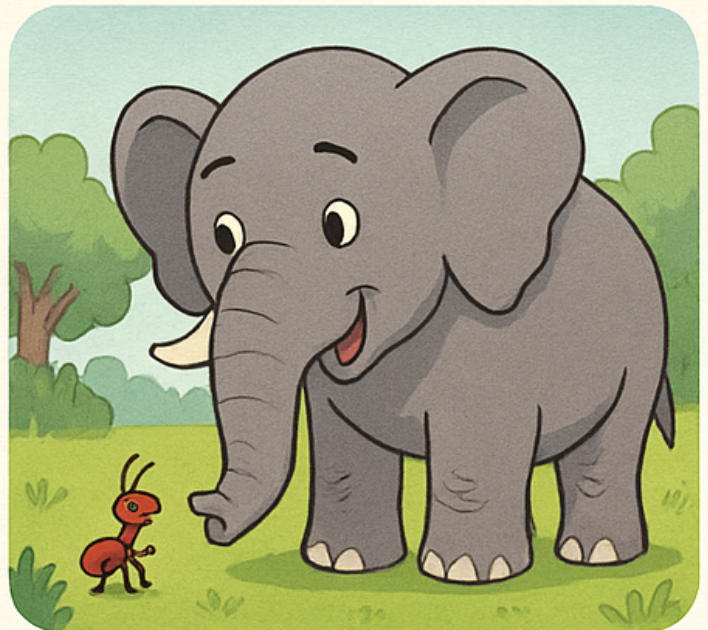
An ant and an elephant met in the forest. The elephant boasted about his size and strength, laughing at tiny ant.

A Moral Story About Truthfulness



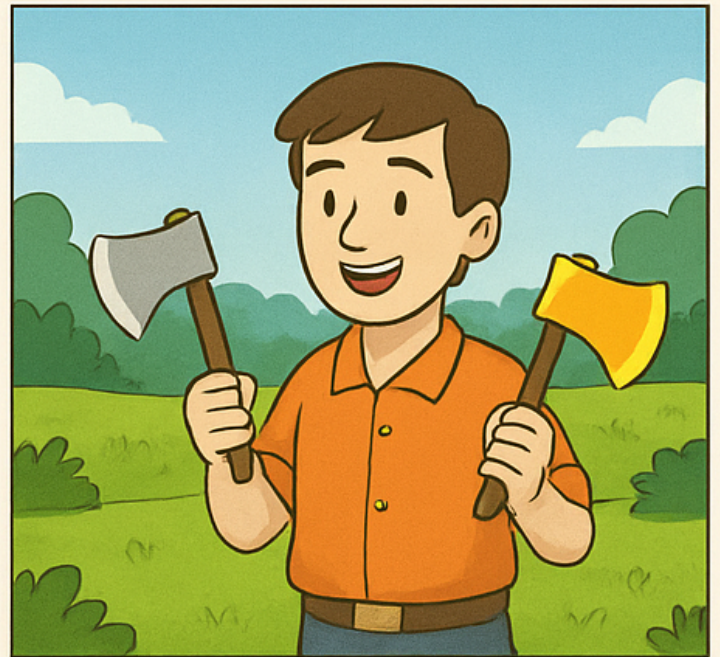
A woodcutter was chopping wood by a river. By accident, his axe fell into water.
