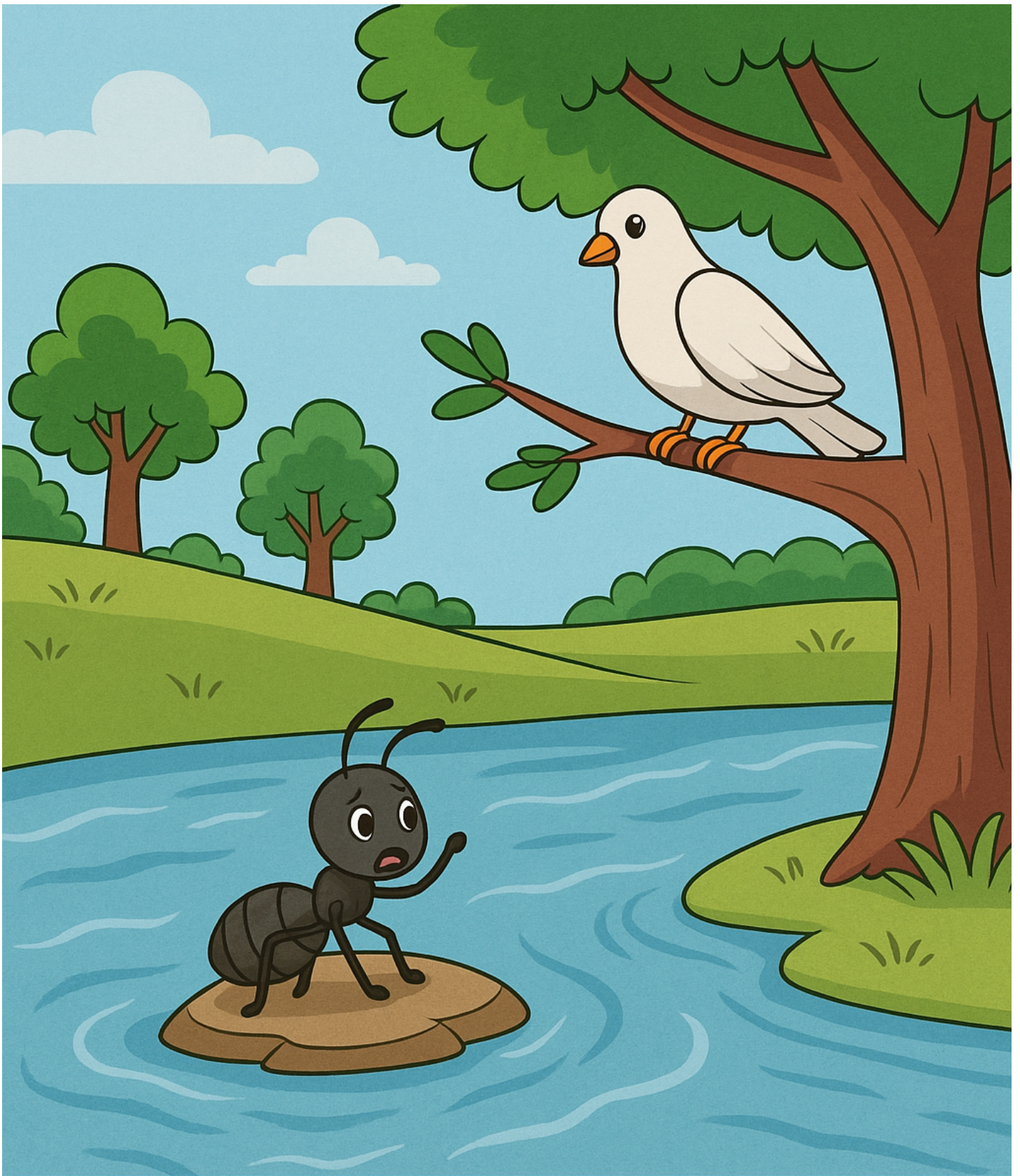



One hot day, an ant was

a river.




An Ant was in danger of drowning in a stream. A Dove sitting on a branch of a nearby tree saw the Ant's plight.

A Ant was walking near a stream when it slipped and fell into the water.



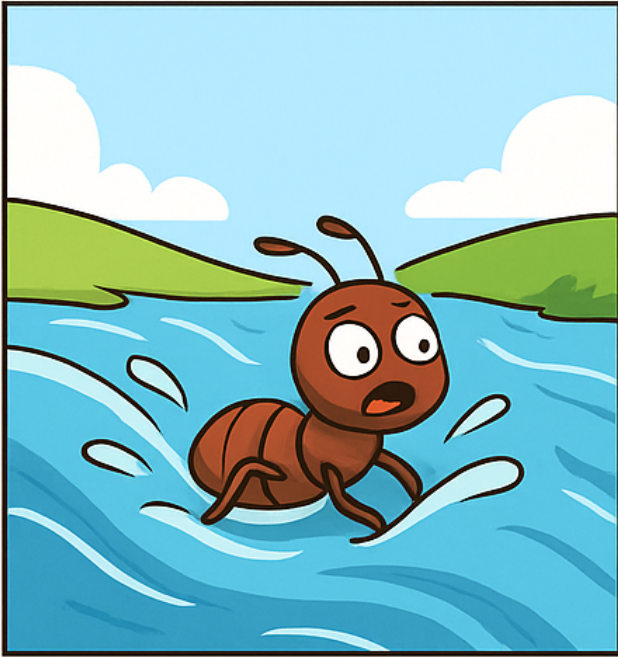
A Dove sitting in a tree saw the ant in trouble. She plucked a leaf and dropped it into the stream.

The ant climbed onto the leaf and floated safely to the shore.

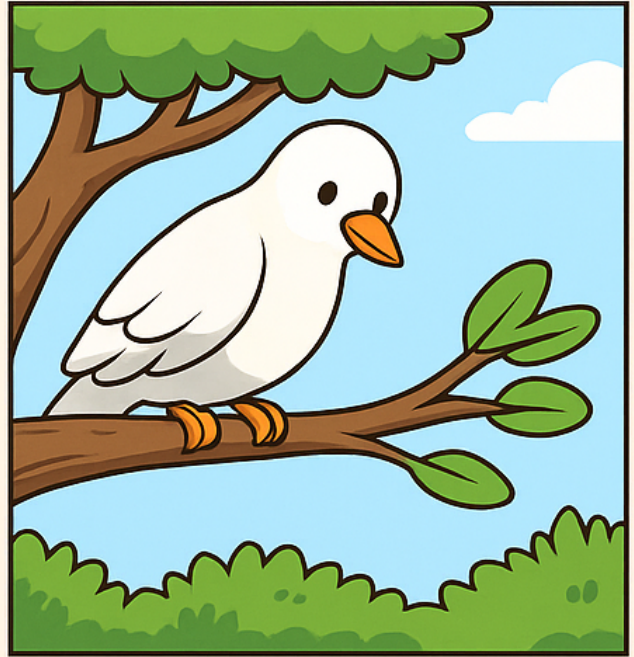

A Story About Kindness



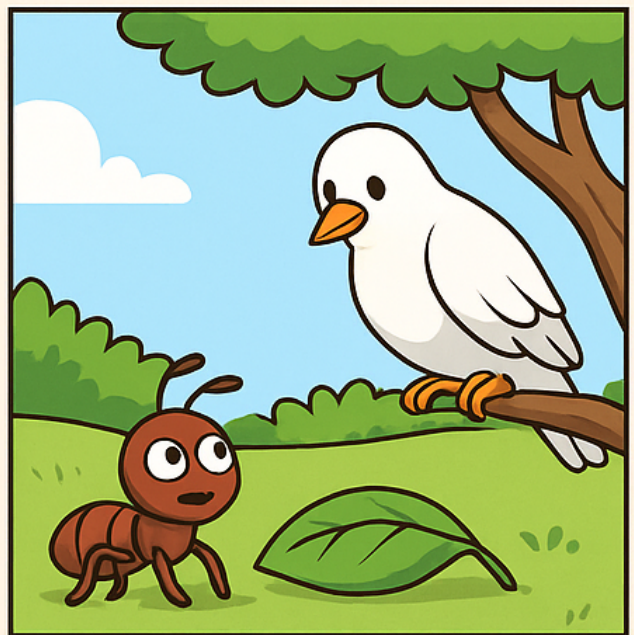
One day, an ant was swept away by a swift river.




A dove in a tree saw the ant trouble.




The dove dropped a twig into the water.




The ant grabbed the leaf and was saved.

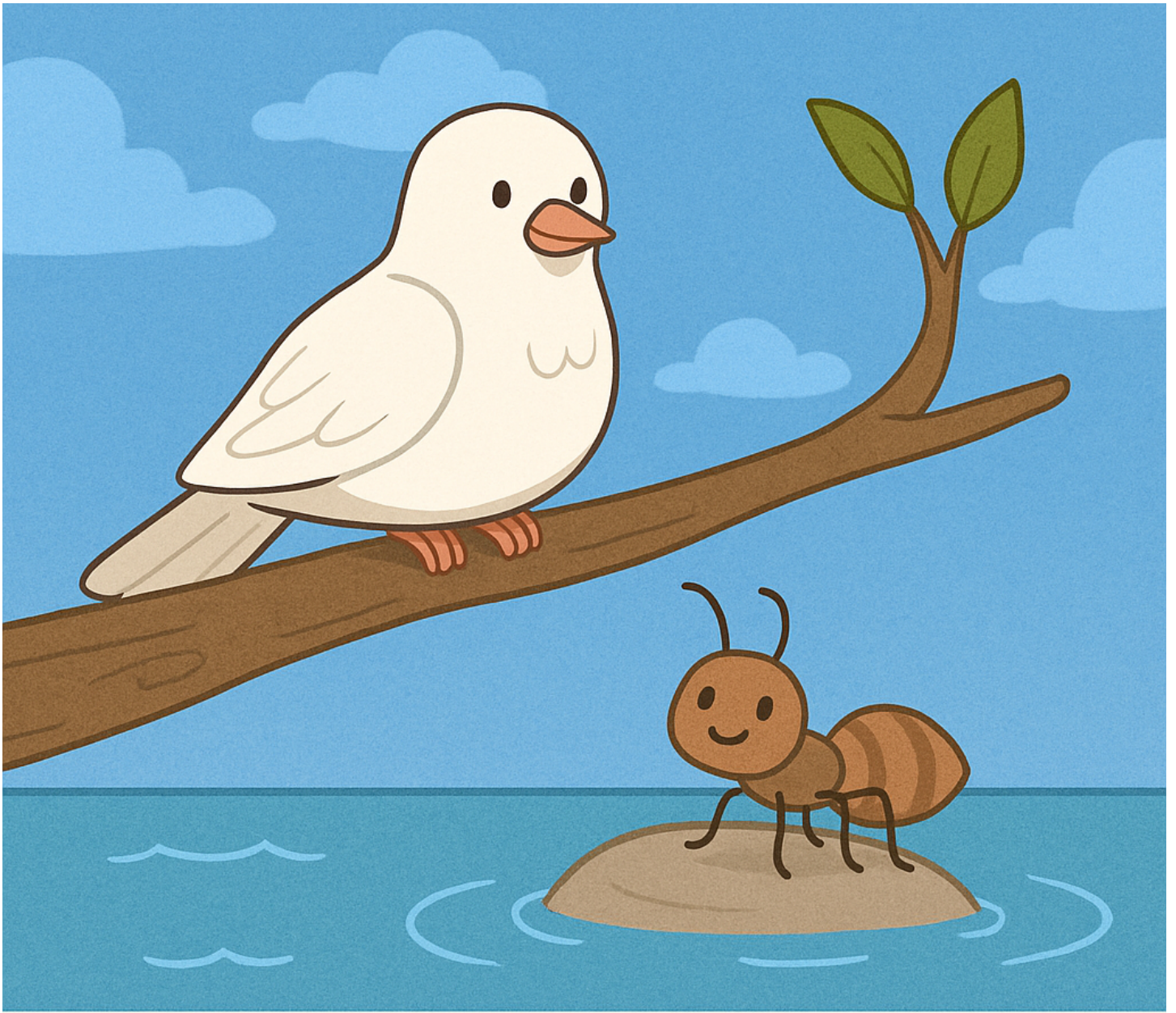
