“A treasure lies buried**



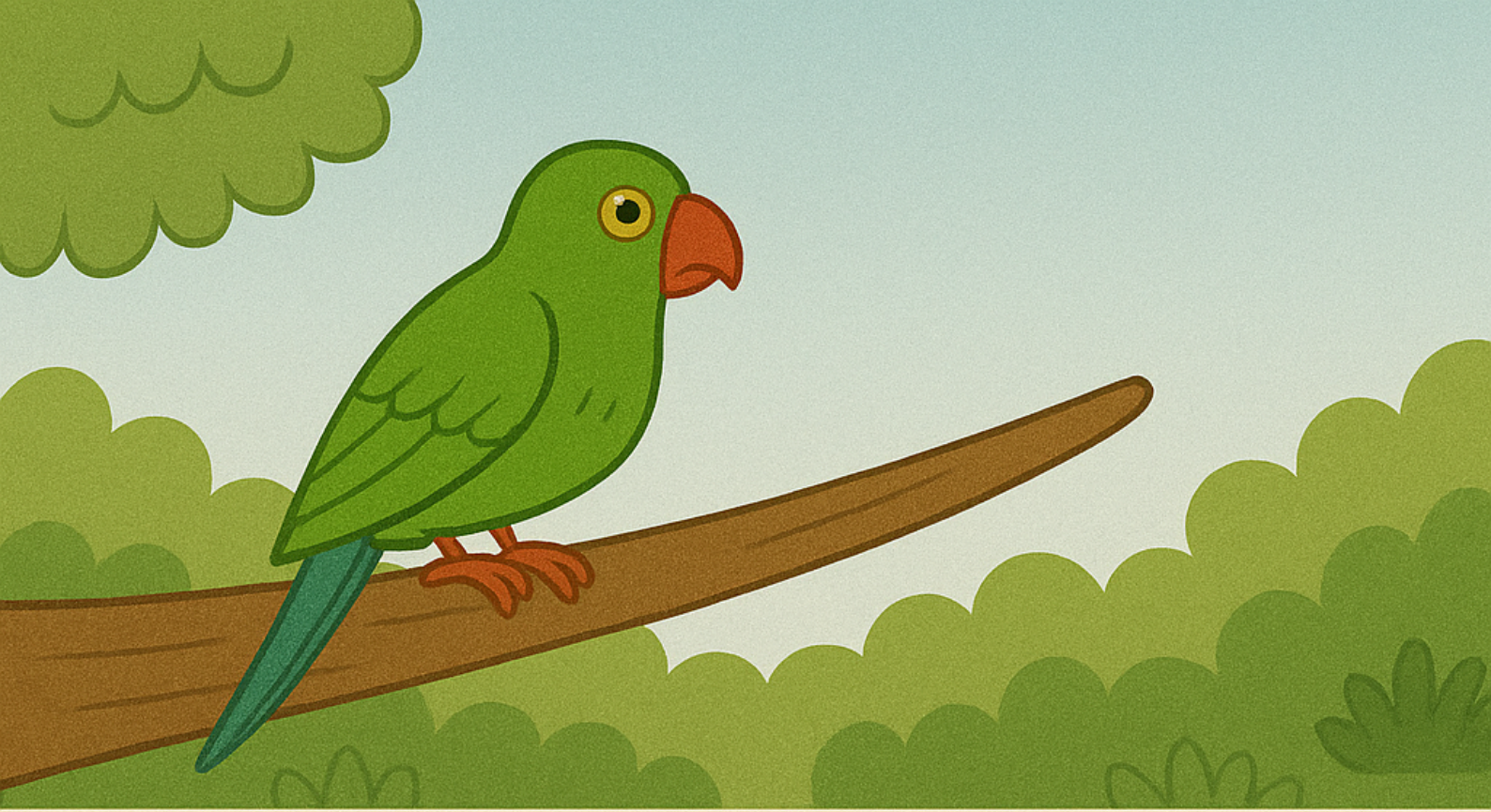
The thieves eagerly dug, but found nothing and departed.

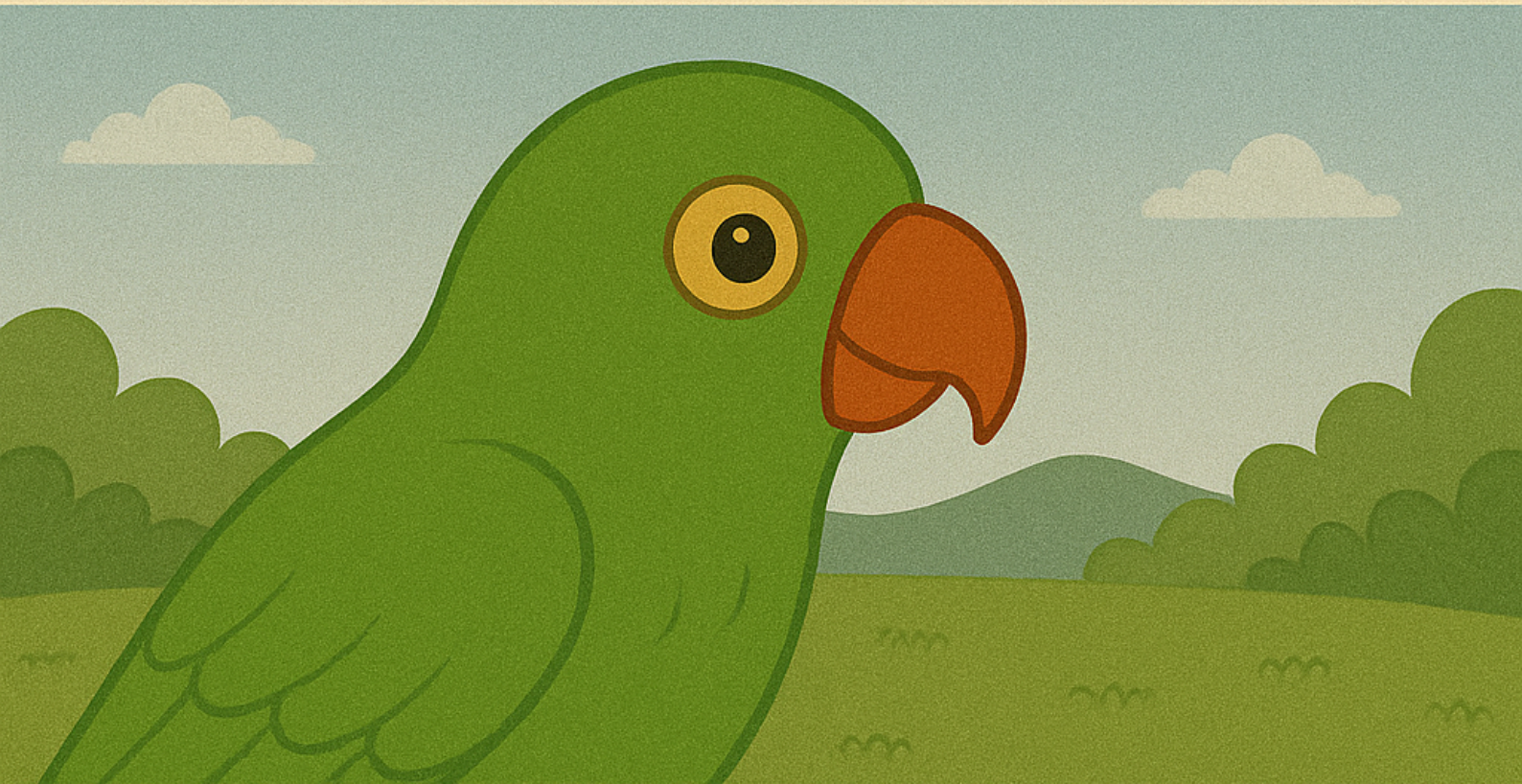
**The Brahmin was overjoyed

returned

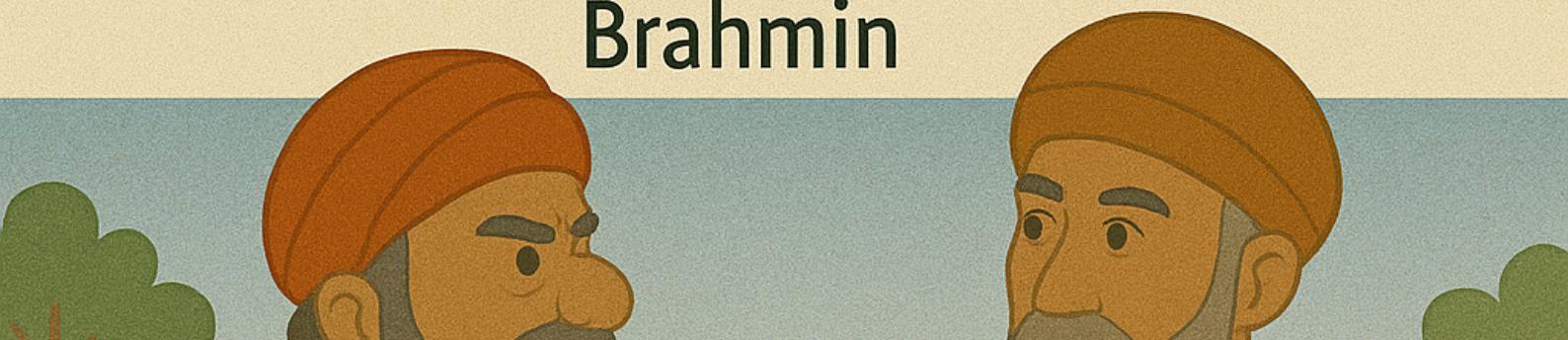

He explained the parrot's cleverness and how it had observed the Brahmin's deceit.

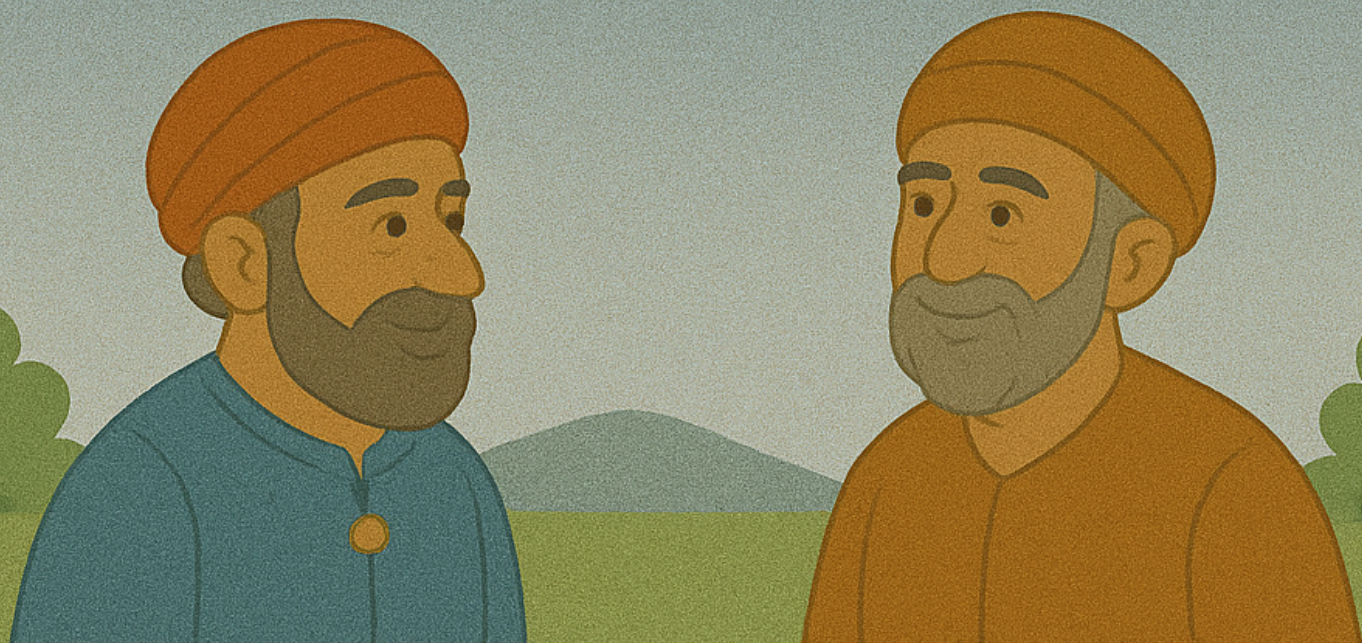


The two embraced, their friendship renewed.

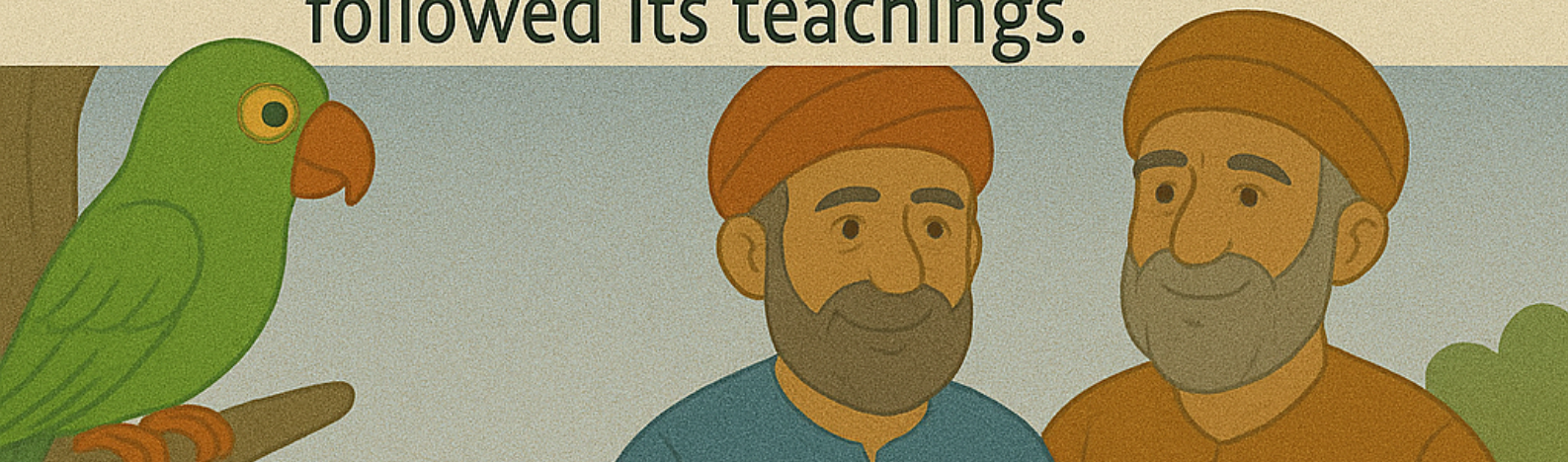




The news of the parrot's wisdom soon spread throughout the land.

One robber stood ready with a stick to kill bird

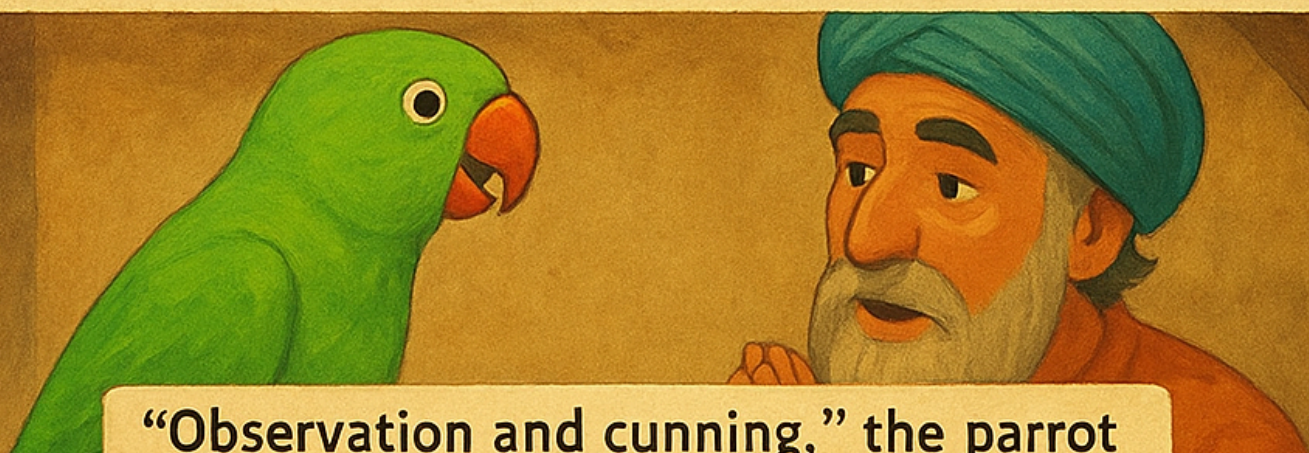




At last, the new customer made another purchase and happily left the shop.
